

The weather for the annual spring bird count on May 26 was sunny with mild temperatures, a pleasant change from the previous two years. The final tallies of 31,009 birds and 175 species are both close to the long-term averages.

The country teams reported plenty of water in the prairie potholes and sloughs resulting in an abundance of waterfowl and related birds; ducks, grebes, and coots were all very numerous. The birds with the highest counts were Franklin's Gull, Red-necked Phalarope (due to a single lake with over 2000), American Coot, Red-winged Blackbird, and Eared Grebe. High water levels limited the mud-flat habitat favored by shorebirds, and the numbers of most shorebird species were below average. Certain common, locally nesting species were particularly abundant. Counts of Purple Martin, House Wren, Gray Catbird, Yellow Warbler, Clay-colored Sparrow, and Savannah Sparrow were all more than two standard deviations above average. Quite a number of species had new high counts (since 1987) including Redhead, Red-necked Grebe, Horned Grebe, Turkey Vulture, Wilson's Snipe, Common Raven, Purple Martin, House Wren, Gray Catbird, Yellow Warbler, Clay-colored Sparrow, Savannah Sparrow, and American Goldfinch. But migrating songbirds were scarce especially the warblers that nest in the boreal forest. Aside from the Yellow Warbler and Common Yellowthroat which nest in the area, only 53 warblers comprising thirteen species were seen. Equally scarce were northern nesting sparrows. Also, only eleven California Gulls were counted; although there might have been more as many of the gulls flying near the landfill were not identified to species. I suspect the loss of their nesting colony on Goose Island due to the high level of the river contributed to the low numbers.

The rarest bird seen was an Arctic Tern, found by the Shadicks at the north end of Blackstrap reservoir. This sighting was only the second reported for the Saskatoon area;

the earlier sighting is listed as hypothetical in *Birds of Saskatoon*. Other locally rare species seen include two Eurasian Collared-Doves, an Osprey (likely nesting north of the city), a pair of Ferruginous Hawks, a Peregrine Falcon, four Piping Plovers at the Allan potash mine, a Whimbrel, three Red-breasted Mergansers near the Berry Barn and a Cinnamon Teal.
